The *Stewardship Associate* works as an integral member of the DLC's Conservation Easement Stewardship team, and is responsible for monitoring conservation easement properties, creating maps, assisting with geospatial data management, and maintaining detailed records in accordance with established protocols.

As part of the position's responsibilities, the *Stewardship Associate* frequently needs to communicate with landowners and hike off-trail over various terrains to document property conditions. The *Stewardship Associate* will use photography, GPS, and iPad technologies to collect data in the field. Additionally, they assist in managing and updating DLC's geospatial data using ArcGIS applications.

Beyond monitoring and mapping, the *Stewardship Associate* will be tasked with organizing and maintaining both paper and electronic records of all conservation easement-related material in compliance with the DLC's recordkeeping and accreditation requirements. This includes managing and updating data in DLC's Salesforce stewardship database, tracking and obtaining copies of publicly filed documents such as deeds, and organizing documents for archival storage.
